Policy 6125: Administering Medicine to Students – The recommendation was to adopt the NCSBA policy to replace the CHCCS policy. The request was approved by the committee. The policy will go to the board on discussion and action.

Policy 4325: Student Substance Abuse – Ms Sanders recommended that the Board adopt the NCSBA policy to replace the CHCCS policy. The committee agreed but asked that the first paragraph of the CHCCS policy be added to the NCSBA policy. The policy will go to the board on discussion and action.

Policy 4400: Attendance - revisions were reviewed and approved by the committee. The policy will go to the board on discussion and action.

Policy 4240: Child Abuse - revisions were reviewed and approved by the committee. The question was asked how volunteers will be notified of revisions to the policy. The plan is to use SITS, PTAs, etc. to get the information out. The policy will go to the board on discussion and action.

Policy 4120: Domicile and Residency - revisions were reviewed and approved by the committee. The policy will go to the board on discussion and action.

Policy 3300: School Calendars - revisions were reviewed and approved by the committee. The committee asked that the policy be reviewed by the teacher organizations prior to bringing the policy to the board. The policy will go to the board on discussion and action.

Policy 3620: Extracurricular Activities & Student Organization – revisions were reviewed. The committee asked that dual enrollment be made clearer and the policy will come back to the policy committee for review.
