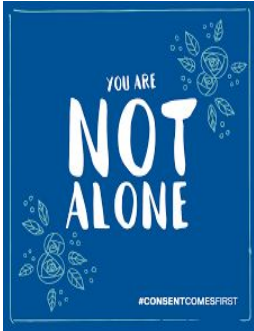


# Fast Facts on Sexual Harassment or Assault
