Although the district's long-term projections show minimal growth in student enrollment, recent legislation reducing K-3 class size requires us to provide additional classrooms for these grade levels. A combination of new development and district-level program options has resulted in significant overcrowding in some schools and underutilization in others.

To address these issues, we are planning a district-wide reassignment process effective in the 2021-22 school year. Elementary and middle schools will be the most affected; high schools will see smaller changes, mostly relating to feeder patterns.

As a first step, we are asking our community members to share their opinions and rank the Board of Education's priorities for student reassignment. Those priorities are balancing school utilization/capacity, socioeconomic indicators, school achievement, and bus travel times while maintaining existing walk zones.
