The ECHHS Honor Code expects the students of ECHHS to:

1. Uphold the integrity of our community by behaving honestly and not misrepresenting knowledge, skills, work or effort in academics.
2. Strive to represent our school with honor at all times.
3. Act upon the transgressions and uphold the ideals that the code encompasses to the best of their ability

What the Honor Code Means:

1. Students must not cheat. This includes anything that gives one student an unfair advantage over another student. They also may not allow others to copy their work, steal answers, or overall cheat off of them.
2. Students should act with integrity and be honest about their work. Examples of this include citing sources, not plagiarizing, and doing all their work themselves.
3. Students should report offenses of the honor code if they see them and uphold the ideas represented in this code of honesty, integrity, and accountability.
