EBSCO Student Resource Center: Use the Student Research Center for easy access to magazine articles, newspaper articles, primary source documents, maps and more.

EBSCO MAS-Ultra: High School research database containing full text magazine articles (some back to 1975), full text reference books, biographies, primary source documents, images, maps and flags.

History Databases to use:

Culture Grams: Easy-to-use site with cultural reports for more than 200 countries with maps and statistics; informative pages on the 50 U.S. states; searchable photo gallery from around the world; famous people index listed by country; and recipe collections from every country in CultureGrams.
